## **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

1. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member or Licensed Player to ETTA Ltd, or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Completion and submission of the entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements, and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. Under 13 and Cadet events will be played as 3 rounds of groups of 3 or 4. The Junior and Senior Events will be played with first round groups followed by a knock-out phase. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Organiser in the light of entries received. Senior and Junior consolation events may be included, depending on number of entries.
5. Competitors may enter **TWO** events subject to eligibility.
6. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start times, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
8. Competitors will be permitted to practise on match tables at the discretion of Control.
9. Players will be expected to umpire matches during group play, and in the knock-out stages. No assistant umpires will be appointed at any stage (x).
10. Players' clothing: main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of balls used (see Tournament Information para 7).
11. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
12. No glueing up will be allowed in the building.
13. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
14. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the ETTA computer ranking scheme.
15. Competitors must be born in 2000 or later (Under 13), 1998 or later (Cadet) and in 1995 or later (Junior).

## **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

1. All entries must be sent to : **Ralph Weeks, 60 Victoria Gardens, Ferndown, Dorset BH22 9JH** by no later than Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2013 together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
2. The draw will be held on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2013.
3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
4. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 7 days in advance.
5. Light refreshments and changing rooms will be available at the venue, together with ample free parking.
6. Play will take place on up to 23 Butterfly and Joola tables with scoring machines.
7. Play will be with Joola (or similar) 3 star white balls.
8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height 6m, minimum court size 9m x 5m.
9. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
10. Play will be on rubberised compound sports flooring.
11. There will be no admission charge.
12. Dope and bat testing may take place.
13. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
14. Trophies will be awarded in all events.
15. The Entry Form will incorporate an undertaking as follows:-
  1. To observe the regulations of the tournament.
  2. To abide by the decisions of the Organizing Committee.
  3. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged unless prevented by circumstances beyond control and accepted as such.

### Playing Schedule

Under 13 and Cadet events will have 3 sessions of group matches. After each session positions will determine the make up of the groups in the next session. Therefore everyone will play at least six matches and no one will be knocked out. The Junior and Senior events will be grouped in the first round, followed by a knock-out phase. Consolation events may be included, subject to sufficient entries.

If in any competition the entry does not reach the minimum number required for the planned format, the organisers will adapt the format as necessary.

## DIRECTIONS

### From M27/A31

Take the A338 towards Bournemouth. Take the third exit towards Kings Park and Boscombe. At the roundabout at the end of the slip road, turn left into Littledown Avenue. After approximately 400 metres, turn right at the roundabout, third exit. After 50 metres turn left into the Avonbourne/Harewood campus. Harewood is at the end of the road.

In case of difficulty, it is recommended that you navigate to the flyover/roundabout at the intersection of the A338 and the A3060 near the Hospital and take the A338 (Wessex Way) towards Bournemouth Town Centre. The first exit is then the one referred to above, towards Kings Park and Boscombe.

If using a Satnav, entering 'Harewood Avenue' is strongly recommended, rather than the school postcode. When you reach the College campus access road (signed from Harewood Avenue), continue to a small roundabout at the end and then through the parking area to the end of the main building. Turn right and through the gate into the playground. Cross the playground, bearing right, to the rear of the main building and you will see the Sports Hall ahead of you.
